1. In sermons

“teachings” – the imparting of positive truth

“admonishing” – to caution, to warn

2. In songs

“psalms” – the Old Testament book of Psalms

“hymns” – focus on God’s character and

“spiritual songs” – focus on God’s care and
what He has done for us

“with grace” – literally because we have God’s grace
