“exhort” – to come alongside and help someone by strongly urging them to do what is biblically right

C. *For Shrewd Sensitivity* vv. 19-22

III. *Be an Encourager.*

“encourage” – to make someone more determined,
hopeful, or confident.

Proverbs 3:27; 25:23; 16:24

“common” – partners, partakers, fellowship

Acts 2:42, 47

B. *We Can Encourage Through Connecting.*
Acts 9:22-28

1. *The terrified saints* v. 26

“assayed to join” – kept trying

2. *The testimony of Barnabas* vv. 27-28

“But Barnabas”

“took him” – seized him, took hold of him
